Born in a family with a rich musical heritage, Vijayalakshmy Subramaniam started her training in Carnatic Music at the age of five. Her keen sense in grasping musical nuances was evident from a young age. Her captivating, melodious rich voice, good control on rhythm, diction and bhava have earned her a noteworthy attention in the music field.

Her accomplishment includes performing all around the world. She was invited to present a paper at a conference "New Directions in Music Studies" at the University of Cambridge, July 2006. The KI Tropentheater, Amsterdam, invited Vijayalakshmy for a series of programs in Belgium and Holland in Jan 2005.
