Josh Feinberg - Sitar

Born into a musical family, Josh Feinberg was introduced to music through classical piano at four years old and later, the bass at eight. As Josh entered adolescence, he became interested in improvisation and became increasingly dedicated to music. He began studying jazz and through that path found North Indian classical music. The music of Ustad Ali Akbar Khan and Pandit Nikhil Banerjee made a particularly strong impression on him.

In 2005, Josh initiated his training with Maestro Ali Akbar Khan. Josh has also received training and guidance from the maestro's senior disciples including Sri James Pomerantz, and Dr. George Ruckert. Presently, Josh is continuing his training with Ali Akbar Khan's sons Maestro Aashish Khan and Sri Alam Khan, as well as his senior disciple Sri Anindya Banerjee. Josh has performed throughout US, Canada and India.

Anubrata Chatterjee – Tabla

Son of the world-renowned tabla maestro, Pt. Anindo Chatterjee, Anubrata Chatterjee was nurtured from a very tender age to be a tabla player. He had the rare fortune of being the youngest and the last "Ganda-Bandh" disciple of the great guru, Padmabhushan - Deshkottam Jnan Prakash Ghosh in 1992. Subsequently, Anubrata continued his training under the gifted tutelage of his father.

He has performed all over India and the world over, including major countries like U.K., U.S.A., Greece, Jordan, Egypt, Croatia, Israel, Germany, France, Scotland, Switzerland, Indonesia etc.
